## UNIT STANDARD 14420: DEMONSTRATE KNOWLEDGE OF ALCOHOLIC AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND BEVERAGE SERVICE EQUIPMENT

This popular course incorporates unit standard 14420 which offers a formal qualification to accompany basic practical skills required to gain entry level service skills for a licensed premise.

The course offers instruction into a variety of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverage styles; preparation, set-up and maintenance of a safe and professional drinking environment. This unique learning experience is held over three consecutive days and incorporates theory and practical applications necessary for a front line service person responsible for the sale of liquor in the challenging, ever changing and exhilarating Hospitality Industry.

### WHAT TO BRING:

Highlighter pen, ballpoint pen and paper. Parental consent must be obtained for students under 18 years of age.

### TO ENROL:

Please phone 0800 762 786 for an enrolment pack. You will be advised whether you need to bring your birth certificate or passport for validation purposes. Once enrolled, an invoice will be posted.

### REGISTRATION:

All participants are to meet at the School of Hospitality Administration Office, M Block, Harbour Terrace. As numbers are limited, admittance to class is only by proof of payment.

Your employer will then be sent an invoice for the course fee. If this letter is not supplied, you personally will be invoiced for the course fee.

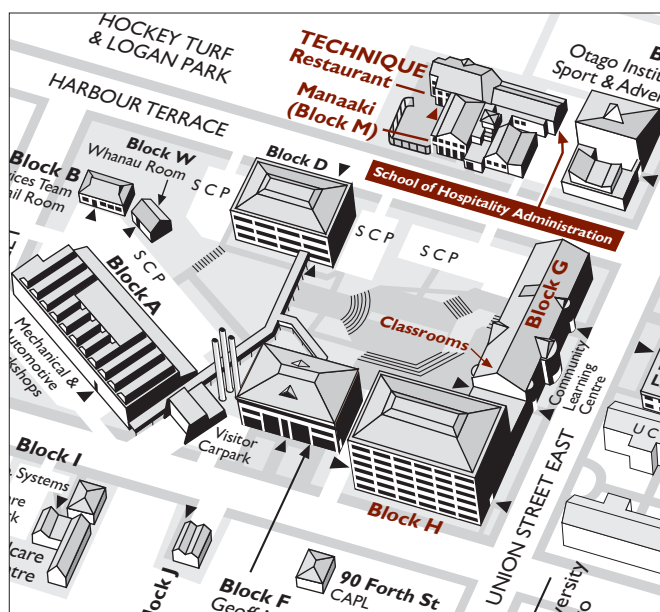
