# Digital Photography (DSLR)

This course is aimed specifically at people who have been using their digital SLR cameras, know how to operate them and would like to try out some of the more advanced features in a practical manner.

**PLEASE NOTE THIS COURSE IS SPECIFICALLY FOR THOSE WITH DIGITAL SLR CAMERAS**

Please check beforehand that you have enrolled for the correct course. It is possible for people with advanced/compact/bridge to attend the courses but the content and intent for the DSLR stream is different and definitely not suited for basic compact cameras. If in doubt, please contact Customer Services. It is advantageous for students to have access to their own computer for offsite assignments and practice.

## COURSE MAY INCLUDE:

Close-up, portraits, food photography, night shots, movement, landscape, field trips or class-oriented themes as the need arises. Course content may change depending on class make-up.

In order to fully utilise the course content, students should have their own digital camera which must be capable of altering shutter speeds, aperture and have a manual focus capability. **Fully automatic compact cameras are not suitable for this course.**

The courses are hands-on, practical sessions with a specific topic being covered at each of the six sessions. Handouts will be provided.

## CLASS SIZE:

Class size is limited to eight students to provide as much hands-on instruction and individual attention as possible.

One session will be held on a Saturday to complete a practical photography shoot.
