This Certificate aims to improve the sporting performance of elite athletes within a specialty sporting area through specialist training and education, enabling students to deepen their knowledge, practical and 'off-court' skills, assisting them to unleash their sporting potential.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Academic entry is open. Applicants must have achieved at a high level in their chosen sport, such as recent regional age grade or secondary school representation.

International Students:

Minimum entry criteria are: Overall band score (Academic) of 5.5 IELTS, (writing score no less than 6.0 and all other bands no less than 5.0).

English Language Requirements for Students of Non-English Speaking Backgrounds:

IELTS 5.5 with no bands less than 5.0

Applicants who meet the entry criteria become eligible for selection.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Eligible applicants will be selected using the following criteria:

- Representation of country
- Province and/or school
- Club in a specific sport code at the highest possible level.

Where there is any doubt about meeting the criteria an interview (phone interview if a face to face is not applicable) will be used to gather further information about the applicant.

Should the number of applicants who meet the selection process requirements exceed the available places, preference will go to those who have achieved at a higher level in their chosen sport. A high performance academy may choose to run a trial in conjunction with the Sports Institute to determine the final allocations.

Any eligible student who cannot be granted admission due to lack of available places will be maintained on a waiting list. Applicants on the waiting list will be contacted if a place becomes available, up until the commencement of the programme.
